This Week's Curriculum

Monday: Children will practice their hand-eye coordination by sewing a cow card. We will read the book "Moo Moo, Brown Cow" by Jakki Wood and Rag Bonner.

Tuesday: Children will decorate a bandanna with paint! We will be studying ponies and singing "Five Feisty Ponies"

Wednesday: We will be discussing the growing cycle of chicks. We will read the book "Chick (See How They Grow)" by DK Publishing.

Thursday: We will paint a pig with brown paint, oatmeal, and sand to make a muddy pig! We will read the book "The Pigs Got Out" by Victoria Sharrow.

Friday: Children will conduct their own experiment by dropping different colors of food coloring into a bowl of milk. Next they will put one drop of dish soap and evaluate what happens to the colors they just placed in the milk.

Bible Time:

Adam Named the Animals

Genesis 1:1-2:20 Genesis 2:15

Adam was to take care of the Garden of Eden

Genesis 2:19-20 Adam named the animals

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. (Genesis 1:1) On day 5, God made the waters full of fish and other water creatures. God also made the birds that fly in the sky! On day 6, God created all the animals that are on the land. From all the big animals like the giraffe and the elephant, to the tiny creeping bugs! God also made Adam and Eve on day 6.
